


## Boquillas Administrative Site Maintenance Building Construction

### Need

The historic Boquillas Ranch is located inside the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area, southeast of Sierra Vista, Arizona. The ranch is managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Tucson Field Office as an administrative site and, seasonally, as a Wild Land Fire Station. This project will construct two comfort stations, install adequate lighting, and construct a covered equipment storage unit within the ranch.

Construction is scheduled for completion by the end of February 2011. Access to the site will not be affected during construction. Specific areas under construction will be restricted. Service interruptions should be expected during lighting repairs and during electrical system start up and testing routines at project completion.



### Recovery Act Funding

C3, LLC was awarded a contract in the amount of \$352,317 to construct these facilities.

### Benefits

This project will address security and health and safety compliance for the benefit of fire personnel, BLM employees and other potential users.
