
## Times Vein Mine Project

### Need

The Times Vein Mine is located in the BLM Kingman Field Office area (Arizona, Mohave County). This abandoned mine shaft poses a high risk to public safety because it is adjacent to a heavily-traveled jeep trail. This project consists of installing an access barrier and fencing to reduce public safety risks and protect sensitive wildlife habitat. This site is about 5 miles northwest of Oatman, Arizona, off Silver Creek Road.


### Recovery Act Funding

The competitive contract for this BLM-Arizona American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) project was awarded to Hausanrufe for \$9,000, and the project was completed at the end of May, 2010.



### Benefits

The reclamation work has closed dangerous shafts and adits to prevent entry by the public, mitigating this public safety hazard. The fabrication and installation of the bat cupola preserves bat habitat in this abandoned mine working. This allows the public to have safe recreation opportunities on public lands administered by BLM.
