Need


Approximately 120 light switches in offices, bathrooms, closets, storage rooms, mechanical rooms, and small conference rooms throughout the BLM Boise District complex located at 3948 Development Avenue in Boise, Idaho will be replaced with motion-detecting sensors that will automatically turn lighting off when a room is not in use.

Recovery Act Funding

Work is expected to be accomplished through a contract with very little interruption to normal business during installation.

Benefits

The retrofit is expected to reduce lighting energy consumption in the complex by up to 45 percent, resulting in greater energy efficiency and considerable cost savings.
