
Boise District Office Radio Building Replacement

Need

The BLM Boise District Office complex at 3948 Development Avenue in Boise, Idaho includes a radio facility and three associated structures in a single building that is aging and inadequate. Communication systems managed and maintained at these facilities are critical to safe and efficient fire suppression, law enforcement, and other operations central to the agency and affecting the public.

Recovery Act Funding

Funding will be used to contract for designing and replacing the radio building. Construction of the replacement facility is expected to begin in February 2010 and be completed by September 2010. There should be little interruption of communication services during construction.



Benefits

The new facility will meet sustainable practice (green energy) requirements and allow vehicle radios to be installed and repaired indoors, with facilities and equipment housed in a single shop.
