




Wilderness Area Restoration


Need

Enactment of the Omnibus Public Lands Management Act of 2009 included wilderness designations in southwestern Idaho (the BLM Boise District). Wilderness areas designated in the Act are now part of the BLM National Landscape Conservation System (NLCS). Boundaries of newly designated wilderness areas in the Boise District will need to be marked with signs, and certain trails will need to be restored while others are obliterated.



Recovery Act Funding

Funding will be used to acquire appropriate signposts and decals and for seasonal labor to place them along wilderness boundaries and trails.



Benefits

The project will properly mark the boundaries of the newly designated wilderness as well as trails within the designations. Visitors to the area will have clear indication of where wilderness management and use regulations are in effect, helping to ensure the wilderness experience intended in the designation.
