





Burley Field Office Door and Window Replacement

Need

Windows and doors presently installed in the Fire Building and warehouse at BLM-Idaho's Burley Field Office, located at 15 East 200 South in Burley (south-central Idaho) are nearly 30 years old, are aluminum-framed, and not energy efficient because most have lost their weather seal. During the winter they also collect condensation. Entry and exit doors in the buildings are also 30 years old, showing wear, and are not weathertight.



Recovery Act Funding

This construction project will replace the doors and windows through a contract.

Benefits

Replacement doors and jambs and overhead doors will be better insulated and have tighter seals when closed, significantly reducing energy consumption and addressing health and safety concerns for the visitors and BLM employees. The new windows and doors will incorporate sustainable features and energy efficiencies, substantially reducing annual maintenance and operating expenses. Spending less on energy and repairs will have the added benefit of preserving natural resources and reducing pollution.
