
Steck Park Boat Docks and Ramps Replacement

Need

Steck Park, located on Brownlee Reservoir approximately 20 miles northwest of Weiser in southwestern Idaho, is a popular campground and day-use area for boaters and anglers. The reservoir is considered the best catfish, crappie and smallmouth bass fishery in Idaho and Oregon. The two boat docks located at the park have degraded and become unsafe. Boat ramps adjacent to the docks are also cracked.

Recovery Act Funding

Broken docks will be replaced with new floating docks. Ramps will be repaired and sealed. Some of the minor preparation work will be accomplished with seasonal employees but the majority of the project will be contracted.



Benefits

New docks will eliminate safety hazards by providing level walking surfaces and eliminating tripping hazards. New docks will also comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Cleaning and sealing cracks in the boat ramps will prevent further damage and deterioration and reduce future maintenance costs.
