

Comfort Station Replacement (Five Recreation Sites)

Need

Existing vault toilets at several BLM Recreation Sites around Idaho are cracked or otherwise in need of replacement. None are accessible under standards in the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Silver City, Idaho (70 miles southwest of Boise, Idaho) is a restored 19th century mining townsite with six primitive campsites. The North Fork Owyhee Campground (27 miles southeast of Jordan Valley, Oregon) is located on the edge of a Wilderness area in southwestern Idaho. The Milner Historic Recreation Area (nine miles west of Burley, Idaho) preserves Oregon Trail wagonwheel ruts; it and Lud Drexler Park (22 miles south of Twin Falls, Idaho) have seen increasing visitation and use in recent years. The Maple Grove Campground is located along the Bear River northeast of Preston, Idaho. Leaks in the Maple Grove toilet pose soil and water contamination threats.



Recovery Act Funding

Degraded toilets and walkways will be replaced with new concrete toilets, and new walkways will be built. The majority of the work will be contracted.

Benefits

New comfort stations will assure proper sanitation, minimize odors, and provide accessibility under ADA standards.
