
## Killarney Lake Dock and Boat Launch Improvements

### Need

The Killarney Lake Boat Launch Recreation Site, three miles off of Hwy. 3, approximately 28 miles southeast of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, offers both day-use and camping facilities year-round on 500-acre Killarney Lake. Aging docks and boat launch need to be replaced.


### Recovery Act Funding

Through contracting, the BLM will replace the existing, aging docks and bring all site facilities up to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-Architectural Barriers Act (ABA) standards. Docks will be fitted with non-skid surfaces to reduce or prevent slipping/falling hazards. Docks, gangways, and piers will be rebuilt and the existing concrete plank boat ramp replaced.



### Benefits

The new dock and boat launch will make the site safer for visitors and employees, improve access for visitors with disabilities, and provide visitors a more enjoyable experience overall, while also reducing long-term maintenance costs.
