




## Inventory of Oregon/California Historic Trail

### Need

The BLM Pocatello Field Office in southeastern Idaho currently lacks adequate information on approximately 28 miles of the Oregon-California National Historic Trails (NHTs) that run across public lands in the Field Office.



### Recovery Act Funding

The BLM will contract for an inventory of NHT segments to gather information on trail conditions, and conditions and associated historic sites on public lands adjacent to the trails. This inventory will include detailed on-the-ground GPS mapping, and the final report will be shared with the Idaho State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).

### Benefits

Having this complete inventory of historic trail segments will help the BLM prioritize future historic trails management activities. Once trail segments and associated archaeological sites are documented at this level of detail, the BLM will be able to better protect these resources and identify which areas need monitoring, maintenance and additional signing and interpretation.
