Travel Management Plan Implementation

Need


The Murphy Travel Management Plan (TMP) designated roads and trails and established types of use on routes across 233,000 acres of the Owyhee Front in southwestern Idaho, an area that has become a popular playground for off-highway vehicle (OHV) recreationists. The plan calls for rehabilitating hillsides damaged by previous OHV use in areas now closed to such use under the TMP; improving parking facilities with barriers and gravel; and installing signs and kiosks along routes that remain open to OHV use under the plan.

Recovery Act Funding

Work will be completed utilizing seasonal employees and contracts. All roads, trails, and facilities designated open for use in the TMP will remain available while work proceeds.

Benefits

Implementing the TMP will help rehabilitate damaged resources and provide better parking facilities and directional and informational signs for OHV riders.
