



Notch Butte Lookout Communication Site Safety Replacement and Security Upgrade

Need

The site is located on public land in Lincoln County in south-central Idaho (the BLM Shoshone Field Office). The existing communications tower is not safe to climb and needs to be replaced. The building has substantial deficiencies, is leaking, and needs to be replaced to protect the radio equipment inside.


Recovery Act Funding

BLM facilities at the site include a fire lookout and radio communications facility. Upgrades and repairs will be accomplished through a construction contract. In addition to replacing the tower and repairing the radio building, work will include installation of a six-foot chain-link fence.



Benefits

Replacing the tower and repairing the radio building will enhance public safety and protect the investment in the radio equipment. Installation of the chain link-fence will further enhance physical security and public safety.
