Ramsey Mountain Communication Site Safety Replacement and Security Upgrade

Need

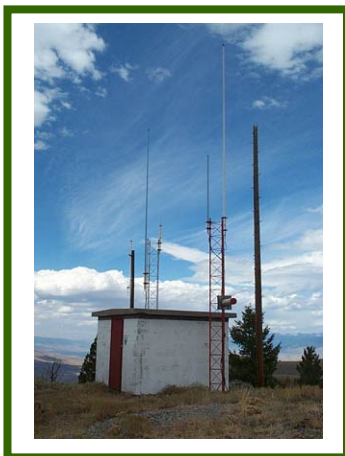
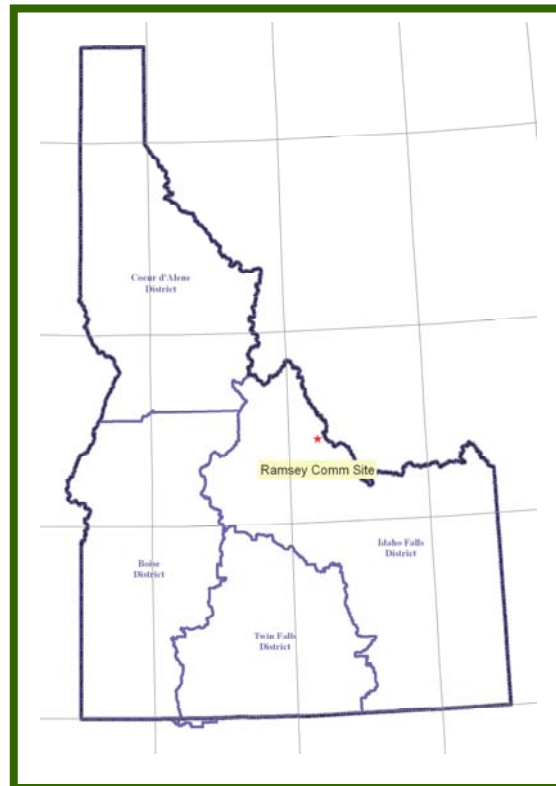
The Ramsey Mountain Communication Site is located on public land in north-central Idaho (the BLM Salmon Field Office), east of the town of Lemhi. The existing communications tower is not safe to climb and needs to be replaced. The building has substantial deficiencies, is leaking, and needs to be replaced to protect the radio equipment inside.

Recovery Act Funding

Upgrades and repairs will be accomplished through a construction contract. In addition to replacing the tower and repairing the radio building, work will include installation of a six-foot chain-link fence.

Benefits

Replacing the tower and repairing the radio building will enhance safety and protect the radio equipment. Installation of the chain link-fence will further enhance physical security and public safety.
