McKay's Bend Recreation Site Waterline Replacement

Need

The McKay's Bend Recreation Site is located along the Clearwater River, 15 miles east of Lewiston, Idaho. The BLM jointly manages the site with the Idaho Department of Fish and Game. The water line at the site has leaked for years and continues to do so, despite patching. Being tied into city water and metered, leaks in the line represent wasted funds for the government as well as a waste of a natural resource.



Recovery Act Funding

The BLM will replace the waterline through a contract.

Benefits

The new line will bring adequate water to the campground at a more efficient cost and without waste.
