Arizona Strip Field Office Trail Repairs

Need

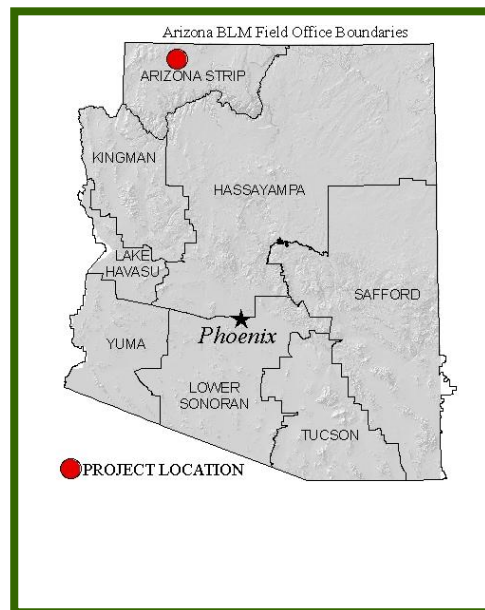
The Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Arizona Strip Field Office Trail Repair project is located in the Grand Canyon-Parashant National Monument. The work on this project includes trail maintenance and repairs throughout the monument to control erosion and to address visitor safety concerns. The Mt. Trumbull, Mt. Logan, Grand Wash Bench, Paiute Wilderness and the Nampaweap Trails are included in this project. These trails provide recreational access to popular scenic attractions and cultural sites throughout the Monument.

Recovery Act Funding

Information about the funding allocated for this BLM Arizona American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) project will be released after the contract has been awarded. This project will be part of a larger statewide agreement to accomplish trail work throughout Arizona.

Benefits

Upon completion of this project, trail users in the Grand Canyon-Parashant National Monument will enjoy a safer and much improved recreational experience. Much of the trail maintenance will be performed by youth-oriented organizations in an effort to provide employment and learning opportunities for young people.
